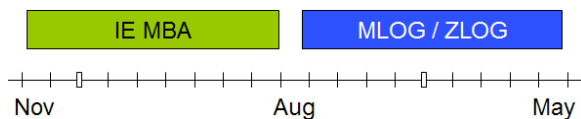

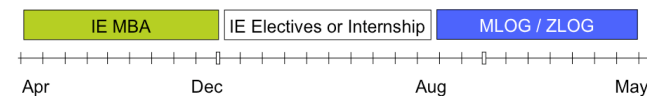
Dual degree structure

Students can start the program in the institution of their choice. The dual degree structure enables the credits received in the MLOG or ZLOG program to count for the 4th Period of the IE International MBA program.

MBA First:

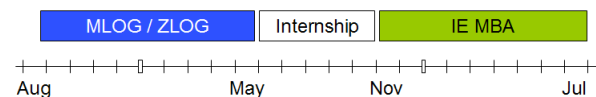


The programs are completed sequentially over a 19 month period, with a short break in August.



The programs are completed over 25 month period with a seven month break between programs, during which a student could participate in IE electives and/or an internship.

MLOG / ZLOG First:



The programs are completed over 23 month period with a five month break between programs, during which a student could pursue an internship.

Fees and Financial Aid

The tuition fees are:

International MBA: €48000 + €1100 (contribution to the IE Foundation)
Application fee: €120

MLOG program: US\$48650 plus student life fee¹
Application fee: US\$70

ZLOG program: €21,500 + administrative fees¹
Application fee: €90

Requests for financial aid will be processed separately by each institution and in accordance with the schools' policy. IE Business School will not charge tuition during the term at MIT or ZLC for students who originally applied for the dual degree.

Admissions Process

Candidates apply to both schools separately and are evaluated for admission by each school based on its respective requirements and criteria. Students wishing to receive admission notice from both programs before making a decision should submit both applications by the deadline of the program they wish to begin first. Some application materials can be shared across institutions during the admissions process (see the table below). Check the website for each program for full details regarding application requirements.
