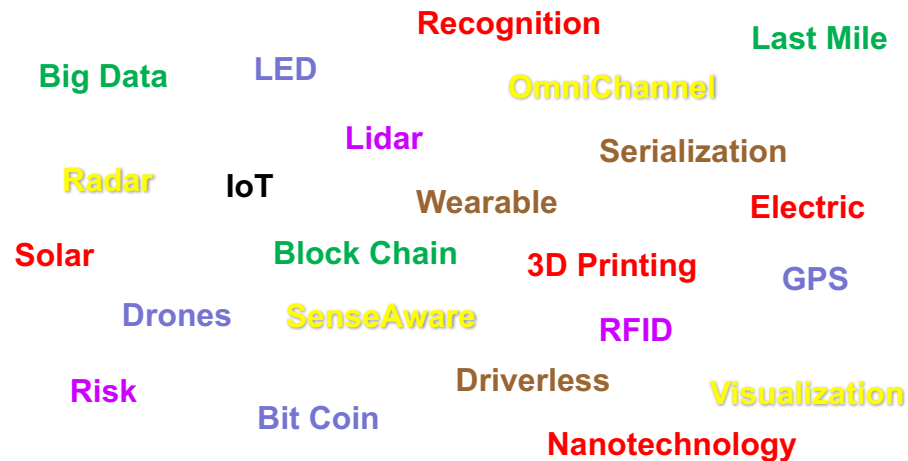
SUMMARY:

The Challenge

1. Invent a new PRODUCT or SERVICE that will improve supply chain management.

- Identify a problem or need in the supply chain (that you can quantify).
- Invent a new product or service that addresses this need.
- Explain how it meets the need and differs from existing solutions.

The Challenge

2. Present a BUSINESS CASE to investors to convince them to invest in your new venture.

- Is the need real? How big is it?
- How well does your idea meet the need?
- What will it cost?
- What is your plan?
 - Team? Funding? Cash flow? Ramp up?
 - Sales Forecast? Marketing? Competitors?

Logistics of Friday Aug 25

- 12 Teams of 5 People each (preassigned)
- 1:00 – 2:00pm ROUND 1
 - 3 Classrooms, 4 teams in each room
 - 10 minute presentation per team including Q&A
 - 3 judges in each room, all 20 students in the room
 - Judges select a winner from each room (not revealed)
- 2:15 – 3:15pm FINAL ROUND
 - 1 Large Classroom, all teams attend ready to present
 - 3 winning teams are called down to again present
 - 10 minutes per team including Q&A
 - High-Level judges 50% + Audience voting 50%
- 3:45 – 4:00pm AWARDS PRESENTED
 - Trophy Presentation, Photo shoots (Dress nice!)

Presentation Guidelines

- Power Point only (free to make up your own format)
 - Up to 10 slides only
 - Below 16 Font size is UNREADABLE (this is 16 font)
 - Use fewer words and more graphics and photos to make slides interesting. (don't have slides that look like THIS one!)
 - Can embed videos but risk of not working when you need it.
 - PPT files must be uploaded to Dropbox by NOON on Friday
 - Speaking time should be evenly distributed among all 5 team members.
 - You should REHEARSE, REHEARSE, REHEARSE
 - Judges will consider both content and how will you present.
