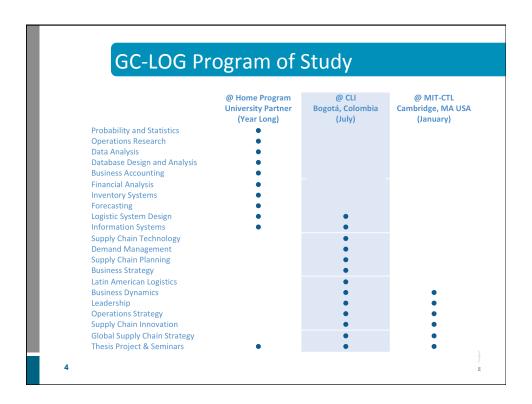

Review Program Cost

- Tuition \$2,500

- GC-LOG Next Steps
 - Phone Interviews (for English)
 - All Material ready within a month
